NASA Midwest is pleased to announce a new Enduro within an Enduro format for the 2010 NASA Midwest Endurance season. 1.5 Hour Endurance races will run concurrent with the 3 Hour Endurance races scheduled for Autobahn July 16, Autobahn September 10 and Putnam Park October 8.

The goal of the 1.5 Hour is too allow a “soft” introduction to endurance racing for NASA drivers and teams. All NASA ECR and NASA Midwest Supplemental rules apply to the 1.5 Hour enduro.

Dave Royce, Region Director of NASA Midwest, Inc. said, “We are excited to offer the race within a race format. It’s been done on the west coast, with 6 Hours within 12 and 6 Hours within the 25 very successfully. Our drivers here in the Midwest have been looking for low impact ways to compete in endurance races and we think this will be a hit!”

“Since our first 2 Hour Enduro in 2007 at Mid America Motorplex our endurance program has slowly gained momentum. I’m pleased that we now have enough interest to offer 2 options of endurance racing for our drivers”, said Bryan Cohn, Director of Competition for NASA Midwest, Inc.

The first event in the 1.5 Hour Endurance Series is July 16 at Autobahn Country Club, where a strong field is expected. NASA’s Endurance races are the only club event’s run on the Full Course at Autobahn, hence their popularity with Autobahn and NASA drivers.
