Saturday Qualifying

Derek Wright in the #913 Camaro got the pole with a 1:38.257 with Anders Sjoblom in the # 65 Mustang close behind with a 1:38.652, Kent Owens # 30 Firebird third also in the 1:38's. Robert Salus in the #24 Firebird in fourth, Bryan White in the #18 Firebird in fifth, and Todd Johnston in the #59 Firebird in sixth.

Saturday Race

Saturday's race was a standing start with beautiful weather. Everyone was off to a good start with Kent, Derek, and Anders pulling away from the rest of the field. Anders had a problem with his transmission which forced him to drop back to third. Kent Owens set a new track record during the race for CMC2 of 1:38.278. The final finishing order was Kent Owens # 30 Firebird in first, with Derek Wright # 913 Camaro in second place, Anders Sjoblom in the # 65 Mustang in third place, Robert Salus # 24 Firebird in fourth, Bryan White # 18 Firebird fifth, Todd Johnston # 59 Firebird sixth.

Sunday Qualifying

Sunday's qualifying was in the rain and Kent Owens in the # 30 Firebird got the pole with a 2:10.6, Todd Johnston in the # 59 Firebird was second, Derek Wright #913 Camaro third, Robert Salus in the #24 Firebird fourth, and Bryan White in the #18 Firebird fifth.
